WORD	DEFINITION

Bat	A large rodent that has a long tail and a pointed nose and can spread diseases.
Rat	A small furry animal that is often kept as a pet and has a long tail and sharp claws.
Mat	A piece of cloth or other material that is used to cover or protect the head.
Fat	A word that rhymes with bat and means a flat piece of land or ground.
Gnat	A word that rhymes with rat and means a large container for liquids or gases.
Flat	A word that rhymes with hat and means a small insect that can fly and sting.
Vat	A word that rhymes with hat and means a small insect that can fly and sting.
